Listed for sale at \$3.6 million, the 3,643-square-foot contemporary home has three bedrooms and four bathrooms. Perched on a corner lot, the home has become something of a local landmark.

There are custom steel truss beams supporting the vaulted ceilings and open-floor-plan interiors. The home has U-shaped living spaces above a walled and sheltered interior courtyard.
